Dear Parents/Guardians,

Congratulations on your child's enrollment in Kentucky's Dual Credit Scholarship program. Our school district is a strong supporter of dual credit opportunities as part of our goal to prepare all students for college and career success.

The Dual Credit Scholarship program is operated by the KY Higher Education Assistance Authority (KHEAA) and provides eligible students up to two dual credit courses at participating state colleges and universities. After two courses, participating institutions charge high school dual credit students no more than the dual credit tuition ceiling rate of \$72 per credit hour.

It is important to understand that KHEAA does not cover the tuition cost if students fail or withdraw from a course prior to the respective college's withdrawal deadline. It is the student's responsibility to know the withdrawal deadline and procedures of their respective college. In these cases, the parent/guardian will be responsible for the tuition payment.
